Disciplines	<p>Men`s singles: A, B, C, U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 groups</p> <p>Women`s singles: A, B, C, U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 groups</p> <p>Men`s doubles: A, B, U-15, U-19 groups</p> <p>Women`s doubles: A, B, U-15, U-19 groups</p> <p>Mixed doubles: A, B, U-15, U-19 groups</p> <p>Participants are not able to play and apply to more than one group, for example, B and U-17 groups! The referees reserve the right to change the order of placing the players on their own discretion. An organizer is entitled to cancel a specific category if there are no minimum 6 participants or move players to a higher group.</p>
Shuffle system	<p>A, B, C, U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 group K.O. system (2 games guaranteed for each player, provided only if the opponent has arrived) - the organizers are not responsible for the opponent's absence; Playing for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th place; The tables are displayed according to the LBF rating as well as the International rating. Those non-ranked players will be raffled out.</p>

Entry fees	A, B, C groups Singles – 10€ Doubles, mixed doubles – 8€ Playing all 3 categories – 21€ U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 groups Singles – 8€ Doubles, mixed doubles – 6€ Playing all 3 categories – 15€
Shuttlecock	Shuttles are being provided by the athlete himself or accompanying organisation. The competition takes place with feather shuttles (players can play with a nylon shuttles by mutual agreement).
Tournament and equipment of the competition	The competition happens after BWF (World Badminton federation) rules; Players will not be allowed to participate in case their sport shoes will not be meant for indoor and will damage floor covering; Player apparel have to be appropriate: short and T-shirt (preferably similar color); On the day of the tournament on the court, next to court only referee, player and accompanying trainer of the player are allowed to be.
Definition of the winner	Participants in each stage for their place get specific amount of points, this information is available in document "Point system". In case when the battle for the first place in overall have one or more players the same amount of points, then the following criteria are taken into account: - highest place in the stage; - next highest place in the stage etc.; - higher place takes a player who got the highest place in the last stage;

<p>Prizes</p>	<p>A, B, C, U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 groups</p> <p>At each stage of the competition, the winners of the first three places in all nominations will be rewarded with medals and sponsor awards.</p> <p>The winners of the general evaluation will be rewarded with the general sponsor VICTOR awards in cooperation with the sports shop BESPORT.LV</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>The state of health of the participants is the responsibility of his or her organization, the participant himself or his accompanying person.</p>

Competition referees	Referee of the game is player who lost previous game.
Disqualification	<p>The Referees of tournament may disqualify a player if he or she:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Repeatedly violating the rules of the game or the rules of the competition; 2. Changes result that has been passed to the secretariat; 3. Willfully lose the game; 4. Requires other players to intentionally play for a specific result; 5. Seriously hinders the competition; 6. During the competition is under the influence of intoxicating substances; 7. Damages the competition or any other equipment at the venue; 8. Regarding abusive behavior during the competition and playing with uncensored words, the participant receives an warning - yellow card, the player receives a red card for re-action and is disqualified from the competition.
Protests	<p>The protest must be notified to the Chief Referee immediately after the match;</p> <p>The protest shall be examined by the Chief Referee at the venue without any pledge of money.</p>
