Mixed – 4 males + 4 females <p>A player can compete in not more than one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles event in any eligible age groups. Online Entry

All entries must be submitted via Member Associations in the online entry system. Closing Date: **Friday ,01 October 2021** BWF headquarters time 23.59 hour (GMT +08.00)

Member Associations are advise to log in into online entry system link for BWF World Senior Championships 2021: <https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/4199C35B-7F1E-4CBF-A6EF-8FCF856AA909> and submit the entries online.

Please ensure to submit your entries in ranking order to ensure your players are correctly separated in the draw.

The order of entries, as made by each Member in the group entry system, is considered to be the national ranking order. Entries with an existing World Ranking will prioritised over national ranking order.

Separation of entries:

The Entries from any one Member shall be drawn as follows:

If a knock out draw only (i.e. more than 16 entries):

- the first and second ranked entries from the Member are drawn by lot in opposite halves of the draw;
- the third and fourth ranked entries are drawn by lot in remaining quarters.

If group play only (i.e. 1-5 entries):

- no national separation.

If group play followed by knock out (i.e. 6-16 entries):

- the first and second ranked entries from the Member are drawn by lot into separate groups.

Players must possess BWF ID numbers to submit their online entries. Players without BWF ID numbers are requested to contact your National Association to obtain BWF ID Numbers through online ID system.

In the online entry system, players CANNOT make a request as "Partner Wanted". Players who are keen to partner a player from different Member Association in the doubles event are requested to contact their Member Association sufficiently in advance for approval before the closing date.

Entries will not be accepted if a Member Association's 2021 subscription has not been paid or their National Association is suspended by BWF.

Substitutions	<p>After the closing date for entries, a player who has entered may be unable to take part through illness, injury, or other unavoidable cause. All information about the current requirements to entry to Spain is available here: www.spth.gob.es/info-pcr</p> <p>Health QR code All participants traveling to Spain must fill out the details of the Health Control Form (FCS) to obtain a QR code, which will need to be shown upon arrival. The form can be completed either on the Spain Travel Health (SpTH) website www.spth.gob.es/create or on the SpTH app. The download link for the app are as below. Android: https://spain-travel-health.en.uptodown.com/android Apple: https://apps.apple.com/us/app/spth/id1521156190</p> <p>Before the trip: Before traveling to Spain, make sure you have signed the form, on the https://www.spth.gob.es or in the mobile app. With this you will get the Health QR Code that you will have to show (paper or mobile) at the airport health control to be able to continue your trip. If you sign the form from the app, it will appear in the 'My Travel' section, in addition to receiving an email that you can print.</p> <p>You can only complete the health-related questions and sign the completed form 48 hours before your arrival in Spain.</p> <p>In the airport: once at the airport, you must show the QR Code that will be scanned at the health control, in order to access the terminal and collect your luggage.</p> <p>1.2. 2. Travelling to-from FARO (PORTUGAL) AIRPORT: Please note that conditions for travelling through Faro International Airport must be check with Portugal's autohorities thourght their official website.

3. Insurance

Specific COVID-19 insurance is not currently required to enter Spain. However, all participants must have personal insurance covering any situation included Covid-19 hospitalization, quarantine and any other costs. The Local Organising Committee and BWF are not responsible for any insurance costs related to COVID-19 during the tournament.

4. Hotels

For security reasons, it is a condition of entry that all participants must stay in the official hotels.

5. What COVID-19 prevention measures are recommended in Spain? Which ones are mandatory?

- a. To maintain a physical interpersonal distance of at least 1.5 metres with non-cohabitants.
- b. To wash hands frequently and thoroughly.
- c. Respiratory etiquette: when coughing or sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with the inside of your elbow. Use tissues to remove respiratory secretions and throw them away after use. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth, as hands facilitate the transmission of coronaviruses.
- d. Masks must be worn by those over 6 years of age:
 - o On public transport.
 - o On public roads, in open air spaces and in any enclosed space for public use or open to the public, whenever it is not possible to ensure the maintenance of an interpersonal safety distance of at least 1.5 metres.

More information will be distributed before the tournament.

6. Positive test protocol

In the event of a positive test the participant and direct/close contacts are required to follow the instructions of the LOC, BWF and the local authorities at all times which may result in players being withdrawn from the tournament. More information on these protocols will be released closer to the event.

7. COVID-19 test services

The local organisers will offer an exclusive COVID test service (PCR or Antigen) for all participants who have made their

	reservations through the official travel agency. Prices will be advised in advance.
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
